

ENDURO ALPE ADRIA CHAMPIONSHIP

GENERAL REGULATIONS 2007

Art. 1

FMNs members of the Alpe Adria Motorcycle Union are:

Art. 2

Admitted riders with a valid licence of an AAMU FMN together with the starting permission. The events will be held under these General Regulations and the FIM rules. All events will be entered in the calendar of the UEM.

Art. 3

Calendar of Enduro AA Championship 2007

Art. 4

The classes will be as follow:

- E 1 125 cc 2st. - 250 cc.4st.
- E 2 250 cc.2st. - 400 cc.4st.
- E 3 + 250 cc.2st. - 500 cc.4st.

Art. 5

For the final classification the 6 best results, (or 5, 4...best results in the case of 6, 5...events) will be taken in consideration, Enter in the final classification only the riders that taken part at least at 1 event out of their own nation.

Art. 6

In the two-days events, enter in the Enduro AA Championship only the results of second day.

Art. 7

In Croatia are accepted tires not homologated by FIM.

Art. 8

For organizatory requirements the events of Enduro AA Championship can take place together with other races, but with separated classifications.

Art. 9

All events of the Enduro AA Championship must take place on Sunday.

Art. 10

The administrative verifications for the foreign riders will take place on Sunday; at the discretion of the organizer also Saturday but to mention explicitly in the Supplementary Regulations.

Art. 11

Must take place at least 2 special tests in every lap: if possible 1 C.T. (cross test) and 1 E.T. (enduro test). The E.T. of the first lap will not be timed.

Art. 12

The organizer must send to the AAMU Secretary the classifications by class. In case of other subdivisions must be extrapolate corresponding to the classes foreseen in the Art.4.

Art. 13

The classification for National Teams will be obtained from the classifications of classes, calculating the 3 best riders, independently of the classes.

Art. 14

The entry fee is at maximum € 50,00 or corresponding value in other currencies according to the daily exchange rates.

The entry fee must reach to the organizer within the prescribed time or through the administrative verifications.

Art. 15

The Supplementary Regulations shall be sent in duplicate not later than 1 month before the event to the Enduro Coordinator for approval; than the Enduro Coordinator will send the confirmed SR to Alpe Adria Secretariat and to all the AA FMN.

For the compilation of the classifications is adopted the FIM score:

Art. 17

The organizer give a prize at least to the first 3 riders and national teams.

Art. 18

The environmental tape is compulsory in the services area (refuelling/paddock/assistance) in accordance with UEM Rules (size 200 x 100).

Art. 19

For what is not specified in these General Regulations have validity the rules of the FIM Code.
