

# ALPE ADRIA NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIP 2010

The competition is valid for National Teams.

Each Nation may enter a maximum of:

- 1 National Team E1,
- 1 National Team E2,
- 1 National Team E3,
- 1 National Junior Team,
- 1 National Veteran Team.

Each National Team **may consist of a maximum of 3 riders (scores of 2 to count).**

**Riders in the National Teams must have competed at least in 1 round of the Alpe Adria European Regional Championship in the current year.**

The National Teams must consist of riders from the same Nation.  
One rider can only be a member of one team.

The Inscription will close 7 days before the event. The organiser will publish a list of riders and teams eligible to take part at least 4 days before the event.

**The Classification for National Teams will be determined from the sum of times taken by the best 2 of 3 riders of the Team, in both 2 days of competition.**

A team with a rider who fails to finish a day will be penalised two hours and the rider will be allowed to re-start the next day.

The winner of each day of competition is the team with the lowest summary time. In case of a tie, the winner will be the team with the rider who has the best (lowest) time.

The winner of Nations Championship is the National Team with the lowest summary time (of two days event).

Prizes will be given by the organizer, to the first 3 National Teams.

The number plates for each category are yellow with black numbers.

A rider, who arrives at a time check more than 60 minutes after his original starting time for the day's run, is automatically excluded.
